

God in Christ gives us the water welling up for eternal life. With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

All Lord, give us this water, and we shall thirst no more.

The Water is poured into the Font.

Almighty God, who anointed Jesus at his Baptism with the Holy Spirit and revealed him as your beloved Son: give to us who are born of water and the Spirit, the will to surrender ourselves to your service, that we may rejoice to be called your children; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ, who took our human nature died for us and rose again?

All I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in his Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

All I believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

All This is our faith.

We believe and trust in one God,
Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

May we your servants who have been washed in them be made one with your Son, who took the form of a servant.

All Lord, receive our prayer.

May your holy Spirit, who has brought us to new birth in the family of your Church, raise us in Christ, our anointed Lord, to full and eternal life.

All Lord, receive our prayer.

For all might, majesty and dominion are yours, now and for ever.
