#### Stabat Mater by Giovanni Battista Pergolesi (1710-1736)

- L. Stabat Mater dolorosa juxta crucem lacrimosa dum pendebat Filius
- I. The sorrowful Mother stood full of tears by the Cross while her Son was hanging there
- 2. Cuius animam gementem contristatam et dolentem pertransivit gladius
- 2. Her soul, sighing, anguished and grieving, was pierced by a sword

# Reading and reflection: John 19.25-27

- 3. O quam tristis et afflicta fuit illa benedicta mater unigeniti
- 3. O how sad and afflicted was that blessed Mother of her Only-begotten Son
- cum videbat nati poenas incliti
- 4. Quae moerebat et dolebat et tremebat 4. She mourned and lamented and trembled when she saw the pains of her glorious Son

- 5. Quis est homo qui non fleret Matri Christi si videret in tanto supplicio?
- 5. What man would not weep if he saw the Mother of Christ in such torment?

Quis non posset contristari Matrem Christi contemplari dolentum cum filio?

Who would not share her sorrow, seeing the loving Mother grieving with her Son?

Pro peccatis suae gentis vidit lesum in tormentis et flagellis subditum

She saw Jesus in torment and subjected to scourging for the sins of His people.

6. Vidit suum dulcem natum moriendo desolatum dum emisit spiritum

6. She saw her sweet offspring dying, forsaken, while He gave up his spirit

- 7. Eia Mater, fons amoris, me sentire vim doloris fac ut tecum lugeam
- 7. O Mother, fount of love, make me to feel the strength of your grief, so that I may mourn with you
- 8. Fac ut ardeat cor meum in amando Christum Deum ut sibi complaceam
- 8. Grant that my heart may burn in the love of Christ my Lord, that I may greatly please Him

Reading and reflection: Luke 23.44-49

Reading and reflection: Luke 23.50-56

9. Sancta Mater, istud agas, crucifixi fige plagas cordi meo valide

9. Holy Mother, grant that the wounds of the Crucified drive deep into my heart.

Tui nati vulnerati tam dignati pro me pati poenas mecum divide

Share with me the agony of your wounded Son who deigned to suffer so much for me

Fac me vere tecum flere crucifixo condolere donec ego vixero

Make me with you lovingly to weep, and share the suffering of the Crucified, as long as I shall live

luxta crucem tecum stare te libenter sociare in planctu desidero

To stand with you beside the Cross and to be your companion in grief is my desire

Virgo virginum praeclara mihi iam non sis amara fac me tecum plangere Virgin, brightest of virgins, be not cruel to me now: grant me to weep with you

10. Fac ut portem Christi mortem passionis eius sortem et plagas recolere

10. Let me bear the death of Christ, be a sharer of his Passion, contemplate His wounds

Fac me plagis vulnerari cruce hac inebriari ob amorem filii

Let me suffer the wounds of that cross, steeped in love of your son
