## GIVE & ENJOY! FUNDING RENEWAL UPDATE

The total of Regular Giving pledged to date is £73,117 per annum, which on a comparable basis represents a 21% increase. The total of Single Donations received so far is £13,193 – all figures including Gift Aid.

Excluded from the above figures are those who have yet to renew or revise their current commitment, a total of 22 people. In addition, there are several who have indicated that they will be converting their previous casual donations into a monthly standing order. The latter, of course, has the advantage that the donation is received at regular intervals and not only when the donor attends a church service. In this way it is easier for the church to plan its own expenditure.

Work to complete the campaign follow-ups is continuing, but because of the holiday season is unlikely to be concluded until mid September. At that time, a final report will be issued and a thank you letter sent to all those who have committed their support.
