#### FUNDING RENEWAL UPDATE

The total of Regular Giving pledged to date is  $\pounds$  78,271 per annum, which on a comparable basis represents a 20% increase over the pre-campaign position which had deteriorated significantly during the previous two years. The benefits of the Funding Renewal campaign will therefore at least bring the regular income and regular expenditure (i.e. the General Fund) into some balance. The total of Single Donations received so far is  $\pounds$ 14,693. All figures include Gift Aid.

Excluded from the above figures are those who have yet to renew or revise their current commitment, still a total of 13 people, whom we are in the process of trying to contact. In addition there are several who have indicated that they will be converting their previous casual donations into a monthly standing orders which has the advantage that their donations are received at regular intervals and not only when the donor attends a church service.

It is hoped to complete all the follow-up work during the next three weeks when a final report will be issued. John Sharp
