Seeking to inspire people for the faithful living out of their daily lives.

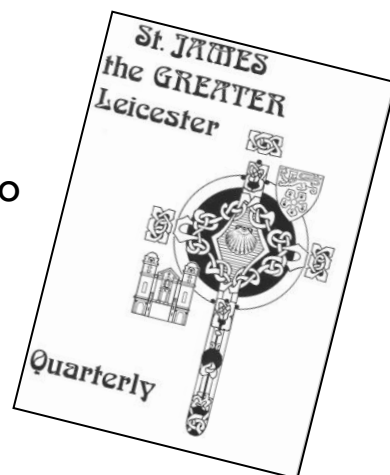
